4. If you took a job for which you were not trained would you not expect to be trained in the fundamental basics required by the position?
5. If you are fully committed to, and believe in the Scouting program, don't you think you should do the best you can in the position you hold? If so, that requires up-to-date training on your part.

The Manatee Training Team provides a unique opportunity for adult leaders to become more informed about their individual positions as well as becoming more efficient at helping our young boys grow up to become responsible citizens.

Cancellation Policy - Once registration fees have been paid, an individual may become ill or otherwise be unable to attend an event. Since the event has already incurred expenses related to the activity such as program supplies, food, patches, etc., event fees are non-refundable & non-transferrable.
