Purpose: To Examine GOD's Laws - Enjoy nature, and a magnificent facility.

Who: All Cub Scouts, Girl Scouts, and American Heritage Girls **in grades 1 through 5**, of the Venice Dioceses and/or Southwest Florida Council, parents & siblings. Stroller and wheel chair accessible.

Preparation: Wear appropriate shoes and clothes (Field Uniform/Class A), carry water bottle to stay hydrated, wear sun block and insect repellent. Practice Leave no Trace and the Buddy System. A LIGHT LUNCH will be provided.

Program: Participants will "Check in" at 8:30 a.m. at the Desk and assigned a starting point along the hiking trail. Several stops are designated to examine a law. Law discussions will last approximately 10 minutes and travel time between stops of 5 minutes. (So, a law program starts on each quarter hour.) After all stops have been visited, we will gather at the Chapel for a Prayer Service and the distribution of patches.

- After the program, participants may visit other areas of the facility, and enjoy a light lunch.

***Online Registration: You do not have to pay online to register online!** Simply fill out the information online, click on either the Credit Card or Mailbox button and then click on the "Make Payment/Save" button at the bottom of the payment page to lock in your registration. Cancellation Policy: Once registration fees have been paid, an individual may become ill or otherwise be unable to attend an event. Since the event has already incurred expenses related to the activity such as program supplies, food, patches, etc., event fees are non-refundable & non-transferrable. An exception will be made if a request is received in writing or email (not phone) and submitted to the Southwest Florida Council Office by the individual no less than 24 hrs. before the date of the event. *In some cases, only a partial refund can be made.* Refunds for inclement weather will be made only if the event is cancelled.
