The Fundamentals of Training

This one day course will provide valuable skills for **ALL BSA ADULT AND YOUTH LEADERS...** not just designated Trainers. The Fundamentals of Training is the **FIRST** part of the three-part train-the-trainer continuum (T3, or T-Cubed) in Boy Scouts of America. The course introduces teaching techniques and skills to new Scout trainers but is also designed to help all Scouters, regardless of their experience, present effective training. Intended for both youth and adult trainers, the course will help those who might have trained for other organizations learn the BSA's training techniques, and it will help freshen up the skill of current BSA trainers.

Interactive Participative Learnings include: Gathering Activities, Icebreakers, Event Openings, Presentation Methods, How We Learn and much more!

Cost: No Cost for this training but pre-registration is required to ensure that there are adequate materials for all participants.

How to Register: Online Registration. Simply go to: <http://www.swflcouncilbsa.org> and click on the calendar button on the upper left hand side of the page. Go to the date of the training in which you would like to attend and click on that training. (Registrations usually open 4 weeks prior to the event date.) Scroll to the bottom of the page and click on the register button. Once you have gone through the whole process of registering, you will receive an instant confirmation of your registration.

Who: All BSA Adult and Youth Leaders (13 years and older), Trainers for Boy Scouts, Varsity, Venturing, Sea Scouts, Order of the Arrow, and Den Chiefs; Unit Trainers and Training Coordinators; current or new District and Council Training Team Members; Pack, Troop and Crew members responsible for teaching scouting skills, Merit Badge Counselors and anyone that wishes to instruct at District and Council Training Events.

What to Bring: Drinking cup and folding chair.

Cancellation Policy: Once registration fees have been paid, an individual may become ill or otherwise unable to attend an event. Since the event has already incurred expenses related to the activity such as program supplies, food, patches, etc., event fees are non-refundable & non-transferrable. An exception will be made if a request is received in writing or email (not phone) and submitted to the Southwest Florida Council Office by the individual no less than 72 hrs. before the date of the event. In some cases, only a partial refund can be made. Refunds for inclement weather will be made only if the event is cancelled.
